

Information on the processing of personal data (Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016) for the website www.iottifrigeriferi.com and www.iottifrigeriferi.it owned by Iotti Frigoriferi S.r.l.

This report, concerning the personal data privacy policies of Iotti Frigoriferi S.r.l., aims to accurately describe the management of the personal data processing of the portal users.

The information is not valid for other websites that may be consulted through our links.

MAIN DEFINITIONS

Personal data: any information concerning an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"); an identifiable person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, with particular reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more characteristic elements of his/her physical, physiological, genetic, psychic, economic, cultural or social identity;

"Processing" means any operation or set of operations which is performed upon personal data or sets of personal data, whether or not by automatic means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction;

Usage Data: this is the information collected automatically by this Application (or by the third party applications that this Application uses), including: IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by the User who connects with this Application, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response from the server (successful, error, etc.), the country of origin, the date and time of the request, the date and time of the response, the date and time of the request.), the country of origin, the characteristics of the browser and the operating system used by the visitor, the various temporal connotations of the visit (e.g. the time spent on each page) and the details of the itinerary followed within the Application, with particular reference to the sequence of pages consulted, the parameters relating to the operating system and the User's IT environment.

User: the individual who uses the services of this website, even if only for web browsing purposes (coincides with the data subject).

Data Subject: the natural person to whom the Personal Data refer.

Data Controller: the natural or legal person, public authority, service or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of Personal Data; where the purposes and means of such processing are determined by Union or Member State law, the Data Controller or the specific criteria applicable to its designation may be established by Union or Member State law;

This Application or Platform or Website: the hardware or software tool through which Users' Personal Data are collected.

1. THE DATA CONTROLLER

Iotti Frigoriferi S.r.l. (hereinafter also referred to as the "Organisation") with registered and operational office located in via Euripide 15, 42124 Reggio Emilia (RE) - Tax Code and VAT No. IT 01644930354, in its capacity as the Data Controller of your personal data, pursuant to Legislative Decree. 196/03 as well as Regulation (EU) 679/2016 on the "protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data", hereby informs you that the processing of your data will be based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your confidentiality and your rights.

2. REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DATA CONTROLLER

The figure of the Data Controller's Representative within this Organisation is not envisaged as it is not necessary in accordance with the Regulation itself.

3. DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

There is no provision for a Data Protection Officer within this organisation (also known as the Data Protection Officer - DPO) as this is not required under the Regulation.

4. PURPOSES OF DATA PROCESSING

The purposes of the processing of your personal data are different but united by the desire to meet your needs and will be implemented only with your free consent.

More specifically:

Pages:

- b) "COMMERCIAL COMMUNICATIONS", to obtain the possibility of receiving commercial information via email on new products and/or services.

We would like to remind you that the optional, explicit and voluntary sending of e-mails to the addresses indicated on the website or, for example, by using the "CONTACTS" service, entails, by its very nature, the subsequent acquisition of personal data; we therefore invite our users, in their requests for services or queries, not to send names or other personal data of third parties that are not strictly necessary, nor particular and/or judicial data pursuant to Articles 9 and 10 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016.

5. LEGAL BASIS AND LAWFULNESS OF PROCESSING

With reference to the lawfulness of the processing identified, the writer specifies, below, the legal bases on which they are based:

- (a) For the purposes referred to in Point 4., letters a) and b) of this notice, the processing of your personal data is possible only and exclusively with your specific consent (Article 6(1)(a) of the Regulation).

6. PROCESSING METHODS

All processing is carried out through the adoption of security measures, both technical and organisational, appropriate to the processing itself as set out in art. 32 of the Regulations. All data are processed both with the aid of computer systems and, if necessary, by means of special paper databases. We use a wide range of advanced security technologies and procedures to help protect your personal data against the risks described above.

7. RECIPIENTS OF THE PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

The recipients of the personal data for the purposes set out above will be solely and exclusively the owners of the undersigned Organisation, the employees and direct collaborators of the Organisation itself for the sole purpose of carrying out the service requested by the user unless the communication is required by law or is strictly necessary for the fulfilment of the user's requests.

In order to correctly manage the service, the processing operations connected to the web services of these domains take place through the company Aruba S.p.A. - P.IVA 01573850516 - Via San Clemente, 53 - 24036 Ponte San Pietro (BG) which provides the hosting service. Aruba S.p.A. has been appointed by the undersigned Organisation as Data Processor (pursuant to art. 28 of the Regulation (EU) 679/2016) as hosting company which guarantees the application of all the security measures pursuant to art. 32 of the Regulation necessary for the protection of the data.

8. TRANSFER OF DATA TO A THIRD COUNTRY

No transfer of your data to a third country or to an International Organisation outside the European Union is envisaged (Articles 44-49 of the Regulation). The data centre where the data resides is located in Italy.

9. PERSONAL DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Personal data are not kept beyond the time necessary to achieve the processing purposes of the specific data described herein, except where longer or shorter retention periods are provided for under applicable laws.

a) For the purposes of the processing indicated in Point 4, letter a) of this information notice, and only with your specific consent, your personal data will be kept for the duration of any service requested or of the resulting contractual relationship. In the event that a formal contractual relationship is established as a result of such contact, your data will be stored in accordance with the legal and regulatory obligations in force regarding the maintenance of accounting, fiscal and administrative records and, more generally, labour relations.

b) For the purposes referred to in Point 4., letter b) of this information notice, and only with your specific consent, the storage period will be limited to your will and, at any time, you may revoke your consent to the sending of commercial communications by following the simple procedure indicated in each individual communication, thus revoking your consent.

10. RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTIES

You have the right to request from the Data Controller access, cancellation, communication, updating, rectification, opposition to processing, integration, limitation, portability, knowledge of the violation of your personal data, as well as, in general, you may exercise all the rights provided for in Article 13 et seq. of EU Regulation 679/2016.

11. RIGHT OF REVOCATION

You have the right to revoke at any time the processing of your personal data as per Point 4. letters a) and b) of this information notice, by contacting info@iottifrigoriferi.it directly or, in the case of commercial communications, by following the simple procedure indicated in each individual communication, unless, following your requests for information, contractual relations have been established, in which case the right to revoke will be subject to legal, regulatory and contractual obligations.

12. CONTROL AUTHORITY

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority "Garante Privacy Italiano" if you believe that your rights in the field of personal data protection are at risk.

13. POSSIBLE CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSAL TO ANSWER

In relation to the aforementioned purpose referred to in Point 4., letters a) and b) of this policy, the provision of personal data by the user is NOT "obligatory", but voluntary.

14. AUTOMATED DECISION-MAKING PROCESS

Your data will not be included in any automated decision-making process.

15. SOCIAL BUTTONS
